2. Three areas tested:
 - a. Reading
 - b. Essay
 - c. Math
3. As of January 11, 2021, the new TSI is available.
 - a. Texas Success Initiative Assessment 2
 - b. TSIA2
 - c. TSI 2.0
4. Two parts to the test
 - a. CRC- College Readiness Classification Test
 - b. Diagnostic level
5. Numbered Items (Questions)
 - a. CRC Reading 30
 - b. CRC Math 20

Diagnostics Level Items (Questions):

- a. DL Reading 48
 - b. DL Math 48
6. Reading Score to Pass
 - a. CRC 945 and essay of level 5 or more
 - b1. Or CRC 945 or less and...
 - b2. Diagnostic Level of 5 or more and...
 - b3. An essay of 5 or more

SCORE RANGES

CRC: 910 - 990

Diagnostic level: 1 - 6

Essay: 1 - 8

In Reading, if you make less than a 945 and a Diagnostic level of 4 or less, they will not allow you to write the ESSAY.

7. Math Score to Pass.
 - a. CRC 950
 - b. CRC 949 or less with a Diagnostic Level of 6

8. Stressing the Diagnostic is your second chance to pass the test.
 - a. Don't quit after your first 30 in Reading.
 - b. Don't quit after your first 20 in Math.

9. Different ways to take the test now.
 - a. Onsite of school or testing center
 - b. Remote with university / college personal
 - c. Virtual with an approved proctor company
(remote & virtual means at your house)

10. Remotely:
 - a. You need a computer that has a working web camera.
 - b. You need a computer that has a working microphone.
 - c. Some remotes proctors are not compatible with Chromebooks.
 - d. Remote you will be asked to use your computer camera to show your surroundings and your work area/table.
 - e. Your phone is not allowed near you or on the table.
 - f. You are allowed 2 - 3 sheets of blank paper.
